Whereas the Kehlsteinhaus (known as the Eagle's Nest in English-speaking countries) is a Third Reich-era building erected atop the summit of the Kehlstein, was known to be used exclusively by members of the Nazi Party for government and social meetings.

Whereas the LAMC Eagle's Nest is not only a place on campus, but also represents faculty/staff professional development and learning.

Whereas the faculty of the LAMC Academic Senate choose to be culturally competent and disassociate from hate crimes and genocide atrocities of the Nazi Party.

LAMC Academic Senate resolves that a the LAMC Facilities Planning Committee and Professional Development Committee moves forward with a more appropriate name, and that Eagle's Nest be stricken from all LAMC signage, webpages and printed materials.
