Accounting is the process of recording financial transactions that pertain to a business.

Accountants are responsible for determining an organizations overall wealth, profitability, and liquidity. Individuals identify, measure, analyze, and report these transactions to other agencies, regulators, and tax collection entities. Accounting is necessary for decision making, cost planning, and measurement of economic performance for any business. 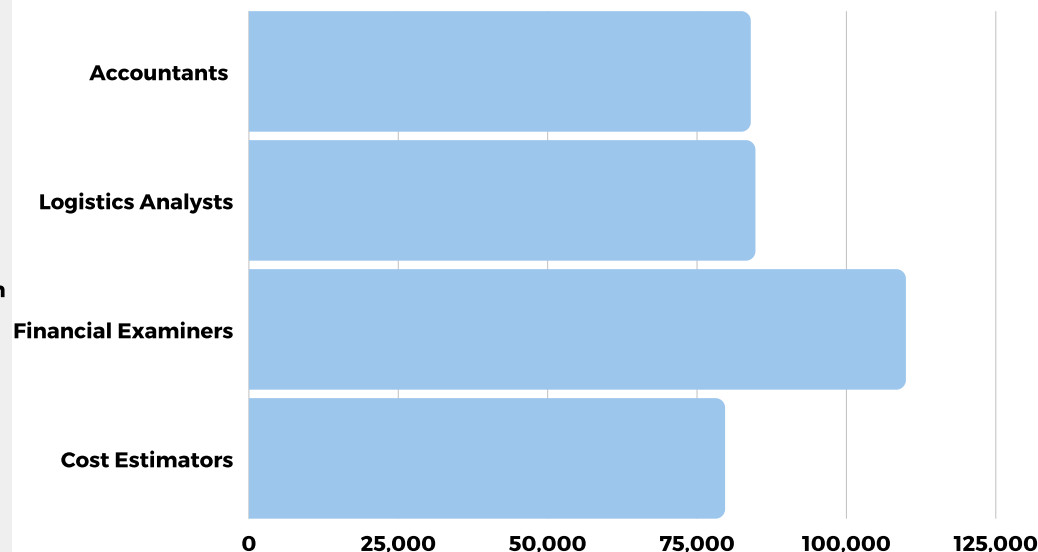
