Art History Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

Students who complete this degree will be guaranteed admission with junior status to the California State University system, although not a particular campus or major. Students receiving this transfer degree must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University, including completion of:
 - (A) The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) **OR** the California State University General Education (CSUGE)
 - (B) The major requirements listed below.
- (2) Obtain of a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0
- (3) Obtain a grade of “C” or better in each course required for the major or a grade of “P” if the major course is taken on a “P/NP” basis.
