

1. Commits a crime. Burglary PC 459
2. Arrested by a law enforcement agency. Mirandize the suspect. Basically read the suspect their Miranda Rights. Miranda vs Arizona /1. Right to remain silent. If you give up the right, what you say can be used against you. 2. Right to Attorney or an attorney appointed for you if you cannot afford one,
3. LAPD, LASO, CHP, Glendale
4. Book the individual, taking the person to the police station for processing.
5. Suspect goes to the jail facility is fingerprinted and receives a booking number. LASD.Org
6. Bail Hearing /Is the suspect eligible for bail? Court makes a decision to OR – Own Recognizance/Make a promise that you will appear for the next court date.
7. /Felony Offenses the District Attorney has at least 48 hours to file charges.
8. Arraignment- To show that there is enough evidence to proceed with the charges. (It is the responsibility of the detective assigned to case to ensure there is enough evidence presented to charge the suspect. Detectives interview witnesses, interview the suspect, interview the victim. Compile all the

information in a report form and submit to the District Attorney. At the Arraignment the suspect will enter a plea of guilty or not guilty.

9. Enough evidence to proceed with court proceedings.

10. Suspect to the Defendant

11. Plea Bargain: Offer a "deal" , Defendant can accept or turn down the deal. Accept the deal, is three years probation, three months, custody at the LACJ. Prior to sentencing the probation officer will submit a presentence report to the Court (Judge)  
Probation Investigation Presentence Reports

Presentence Report: Submitted once the individual has been convicted of the crime/s.

1. Information for the Court prior to sentencing
2. Used for classification purposes if the Defendant is committed to state prison.
3. Used by the prison staff to assist in the planning of the Defendant's program while in prison.
4. Used by the Parole Agent is determining a parolee's condition of parole and supervision level.

## Headings of the Report:

1. Circumstances of the Offense: Who What, Where, When, Why. The information regarding the crime.
2. Defendant's Statement: The Defendant's version of what happened.
3. Prior Record: List of arrests and dispositions
4. Family Status: Oldest, youngest, information about his parents, children, married, single Does the defendant have stability.
5. Employment/Education: Does the defendant have a job, does he have skills, education high school diploma, college
6. Health/Psych. Problems; Medication; Drug Problems
7. Gang Affiliation: Supporting Evidence, police have a data base called Cal Gangs
8. Evaluation: Probation Officer opportunity to express their feelings regarding the defendant and the case factors. This section is also used to justify your recommendation.
9. Recommendation: Can recommend to the court whether the defendant is suitable for probation or

prison. If you recommend probation, you will recommend the conditions.

Rodney King

Offense Section- Group

Prior Record

Defendant's Statement- Develop ten questions that you would ask the Defendant Rodney King:

1. Were you drinking?
2. Why did you flee?
3. How fast were you driving?
4. Where were you going or coming from?
5. Are you a licensed driver?

Generate a defendant's statement.

Evaluation: Rodney King is a 35 year old male, who has an extensive arrest history. His admission to using alcohol, drug use and assaultive behavior, makes him a danger to the community.

Recommendation: Rx Probation

List 5 conditions of probation you would impose:

1. Abstain from the consumption of alcohol.
2. Defendant will participate in alcohol and drug testing.
3. Participate in Alcoholics Annon.
4. Complete a six month program of Anger Management
5. The defendant will participate in 100 hours of community service.

Buzz word:

Nexus- the condition of parole or probation must be related to or have a connection with the defendant's conviction history or recent commitment offense.

Olsonize: Olsonize a document you black out information regarding the victim's address/personal history.

PC 1192.7C – Penal Code Section that list serious and violent felony offenses.
