Course Description: Space planning for interior design with an emphasis on complete environmental planning including client requirements, ADA compliance, architectural considerations, interior and exterior relationships to residential and commercial design. This course includes presentation methods and field trips.

Course Objectives: On course examination, in class discussion, and/or written work, students will demonstrate the following skills at a minimum of 70%.

1. Establish minimum accessibility routes, clearances, and traffic patterns, including ADA restrictions.
2. Provide space planning solutions to spaces with restriction, including but limited to areas that are constrained by size, shape, budget allowances, and environment.
3. Use the client's requirements solely as the basis for the design.
3. Devise public presentations supporting design and project proposals.
