Where: Los Angeles Mission College Health, Fitness and Athletics Complex (HFAC) located on the new East Campus 12890 Harding Street, Sylmar, CA 91342 cross street is Eldridge. This is a BRAND NEW facility with locker & shower. It is about 5 blocks to the southeast of the main L.A. Mission College campus.
