

Learning Support Svc	Function
Disabled Students Program & Services (DSP&S)	<p>Provides reasonable accommodations for students with a wide variety of disabilities in accordance with state and federal law.</p> <p>Some of the services offered are: academic counseling, priority registration, registration assistance, interpreter services, mobility assistance, access to assistive technology.</p> <p>High Tech Lab with nine computers. Staffed with a disability specialist, a special services assistant, an assistive technologist, hourly counselors and six hourly instructors. The director position is currently vacant</p>
Computer Applications and Office Technologies Center (CAOT)	<p>Computer lab with 48 workstations and two laser printers. Computers are loaded with Microsoft Office , Quickbooks, Medisoft, GDP 11 & Skill Building, Express Scribe and Internet access.</p>
Computer Science Information Technology Lab	<p>Computer lab with 103 workstations, three LCD projectors and 4 printers. Computers are loaded with software necessary for CSIT courses-Microsoft Office and Video Studio Languages.</p>
Multimedia Studies	<p>Multimedia program has two Apple iMac labs with 52 workstations. Computers have up-to-date versions of coursework software to support Multimedia courses.</p>
Child Development Student Resource Center	<p>Using Career Technical Education (CTE) funds, the Child Development Resource Center offers the following: workshops, seminars, career pathway information, lending library of textbooks, resource books and children's books, laptops, computer and iPads, help in earning California Child Development Permits, collaborative study groups and assistance with portfolio preparations.</p> <p>50 hours of tutoring per week supported by four bilingual tutors.</p>
Extended Opportunity Program and Services (EOP&S)	<p>Stated funded program dedicated to assisting students with social, economic, or academic disadvantages. Tutoring is offered in English and math from basic to advanced levels.</p> <p>EOP&S has created a lending library of current textbooks.</p> <p>EOP&S has two tutors that provide 28 hours of tutoring a week. In Spring 2014 two more tutors were hired for the area of ESL and Math.</p>

TRIO/ Student Support Services	Federally funded and serves 160 students, typically low-income, some with disabilities. Program provides tutoring services and assistance negotiating college life. Two tutors, one for English and one for Math work ten hour per week.
