Associate in Arts/Associate in Science Degree Requirements

Los Angeles Mission College offers several types of associate (AA/ AS) degrees:

- ✓ AA/S Degrees (Plan A or B designated majors)
✓ Broad AA Degree in General Studies (non-transfer) or Liberal Arts (for transfer-bound)
✓ AA/S-T Degrees (Transfer Degrees)

Each of these degree options must satisfy the following requirements:

- 1. Students must complete a minimum of 60 degree-applicable, semester units.
2. Students must complete all work with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 ("C").
3. Students must complete all coursework in their major with a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher.
4. Students must demonstrate competency# in English\* and Mathematics\*\* (see front page for more information).
5. Students must complete at least 12 units at Los Angeles Mission College and be in attendance at the college during the semester in which graduation requirements are completed.

Petition for Graduation (to receive an AA/AS Degree):

- Schedule an appointment with a counselor each semester to check progress towards your degree.
• If applicable, have an official copy of all transcripts (including those from College Board for AP exams) from other institutions SENT directly to the Admissions Office...
• Schedule an appointment with your counselor during your final semester to verify that all degree requirements have been met and complete a Graduation Petition...
• Submit your petition with all supporting documents to the Admissions Office.

NOTE: Completion of the General Education and Major Requirements for an Associate Degree do NOT make the student eligible to transfer to a four-year college or university. Consult the college catalog, your counselor and ASSIST (www.assist.org) regarding transfer requirements.
