Steps to Student Success



1 APPLY ONLINE

Submit an application at www.lamission.edu by selecting 'Apply Online' in the upper-right hand corner. Applications can only be done by web. You will receive an email response within 7 to 10 working days. Check www.lamission.edu/admissions or call 818.833.3322 during office hours, which can be found on the Admissions & Records webpage. The Admissions & Records Office is located in the Instructional Building, Student Services Annex.

2 COMPLETE MATH AND ENGLISH ASSESSMENT

Visit the www.lamission.edu/assessment to view videos and take sample tests to prepare for Math and English assessment. When you come to take an assessment exam, be sure to have a photo ID and Student ID number. For any questions, call 818.364.7613 or stop by. The Assessment Center is located in the Campus Center, Lower Level.

3 ATTEND A NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

In-person new student Orientations are presented by counselors to review important college information and develop an abbreviated Student Educational Plan. The Counseling Office is located in the Instructional Building, Student Services Annex.

4 APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID
