## Social Justice Studies: Chicano/Chicana Studies Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

The Associate in Arts in Social Justice: Chicano/Chicana Studies for Transfer will provide the student with a broad based course of study with an emphasis in social justice studies related to Chicano and Chicana curriculum that will prepare the student for transfer and completion of a Bachelor's degree in Social Justice Studies or a similar major at a CSU campus.

Students receiving this transfer degree must meet the following requirements:

1. Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University, including completion of:
  - a. The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University General Education (CSUGE)
  - b. A minimum of 18 semester units in a major or area of emphasis
2. Obtain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0
3. Obtain a grade of "C" or better in each course required for the major or a grade of "P" if the major course is taken on a "P/NP" basis.
