

LAMC's Process for Review of the Mission Statement

Background

To ensure that LAMC adheres to institutional effectiveness a systematic review of the College's Mission statement is required. The review of the Mission Statement must follow the shared governance processes established by the campus.

Mission Statement Review

It is proposed that the Mission Statement reviewed annually by the Education Planning Committee, Student Services Support Planning Committee, and the Budget and Planning Committee. This review is to ensure that the Mission Statement is up to date and remains the Center piece of the Strategic goals of the college. Once it has been reviewed these shared governance committees will forward their recommendations to the Academic Senate, **AFT Faculty Guild**, and AFT Staff Guild for review. The Academic Senate, AFT Staff Guild, and **AFT Faculty Guild** may submit their comments to the College Council to keep, edit or change the Mission Statement.

The College Council will discuss the recommendations and decide whether to make any changes to the Mission Statement. The College Council will recommend action or no action to the President for approval.

In the event the College Council recommends changes to the Mission Statement, the College will obtain the approval or disapproval of the entire College Campus .
