1. The meeting convened at 3:30 p.m. and was chaired by Darlene Montes.
2. **Review and Approve the Minutes of the Meeting of October 27, 2015.** Upon motion by Ms. Aghajanian, seconded by Ms. Chow, the Student Equity Committee approved the minutes of the meeting of October 27, 2015.
2. **Status of Student Equity Plan.** Dean Montes informed the committee that the 2015-16 SE Plan was submitted to District on December 7, 2015. President Perez, Dean Montes, and Academic Senate President Leslie Milke presented the Plan to the IESS Committee on December 16, 2015 and the Plan was ratified by the LACCD Board of Trustees on January 13, 2016. The 2014-15 SE final report for Fund 10433 was submitted to District on February 3, 2016 and the expenditure report was forwarded to the State Chancellor's Office on February 19, 2016.
3. **Ranking of Student Equity Funding Requests.** Dean Montes gave an overview of the seven proposals for consideration by the SE Committee. Of the seven, four were recommended for funding: CalWORKS – Know Your Rights (\$2,050); Child Development/Child Development Center – Banner, Brochure, Postcards (\$1,750); Library – Collection for Basic Skills Book Enhancement (\$20,000); and SFVSN/GS Community Collaborative (\$10,000). With regard to the three proposals that were not funded Dean Montes notified the requestors that they have an opportunity to resubmit their proposals.

5. **Student Equity Commitments.** Funding has been encumbered for the following:
 - Net Tutor - \$30,000
 - DSPS Learning Disability Assessment Program (LDAP) - \$30,000
 - DREAM Conference - \$9,950
