ADDING & DROPPING CLASSES

To view add/drop deadlines, go to the [Schedule of Classes Online](#), search for the class by Subject or Class Number, select the desired class and view the Class Details; at the bottom of the page you will find the add/drop deadlines under Important Class Dates.

Add a Class

- A permission number is not required on the first day of instruction and may still be added if the class is not full.
- A permission number is required after the first day of instruction and if the class is full.
- Students must add all classes via their student portal, including those with permission numbers. Permission numbers are only issued by instructors.

Drop a Class

- Check the Important Class Dates for drop deadlines which include last day to drop with a refund/no fee owed, drop without a “W,” and drop with a “W.”
- **If you stop attending class, or wish to drop a class, it is the student’s responsibility to drop the class. Failure to do so may result in a grade of “F” in that class.**

REMINDER: Course repetition is regulated by state guidelines, limiting students to a maximum of three (3) enrollments in a course, to include both substandard grades and withdrawals, unless otherwise specified in the course description in the college catalog.
