



Note: The data in the table below is from the <u>CCCCO Data Mart</u> and may differ from the campus-based data reported in other tables due to differing data definitions and time periods.

According to CCCCO methodology, a student enters the transfer cohort if by six years after initial enrollment the student has completed twelve credit units and attempted a transfer-level math or English course. Students may be concurrently enrolled in high school (aka "special admits"), may be high school drop-outs, or may be high school graduates at the time of their initial enrollment. Students are assigned a cohort year according to the academic year in which they first enroll at a CCC. Transfer cohort students are attributed uniquely to one "home" community college based on where they earned most of their units.

The transfer rate is calculated by dividing the number of students with enrollments at a bachelors-granting institution within six years after initial enrollment at the community college by the total size of the Transfer Cohort. #### **VII. CTE Licensure Pass Rates**

Standard: 90%Stretch Goal: 100%

The ACCJC definition for **licensure pass rate** is, in programs for which students must pass a licensure examination in order to work in their field of study, "the number of students who passed the licensure examination divided by the number of students who took the examination." The ACCJC Annual Report form also specifies that rates should only be reported for programs where there were at least ten students who completed the program in the designated year.

Currently, the only program that requires a licensure pass rate is the **Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)** program, which was launched in Spring 2016. The CNA licensure pass rate has been 100% in every term (Spring 2016 through Fall 2022), except in Spring 2020 when it was 92.3%.

#### VIII. CTE Job Placement Rates

- Standard: Meet the State-set performance goal
- Stretch Goal: Increase at least 3 percentage points over the last reported job placement rate for each program *or* to be at the previous/current year's Institution-Set-Standard, whichever is higher

The ACCJC definition for **job placement rate** is, for students completing certificate programs and career education degrees, "the number of students employed in the year following graduation divided by the number of students who completed the program."

The College uses employment rate data from the Career Technical Education (CTE) Perkins V Employment Core Indicator report (found at:

https://misweb.cccco.edu/perkinsv/Core\_Indicator\_Reports/Default.aspx) for our job placement rates. Employment rates are reported for programs that had 10 or more students completing certificates or CTE degrees that year in the 6-digit TOP code and that also had at least 10 students in the Perkins V cohort that year (otherwise "\*\*\*" is displayed).

The State-set performance goal (and thus the institution-set standard) for fiscal year 2023-24 (2020-21 cohort) was 73.2%.
