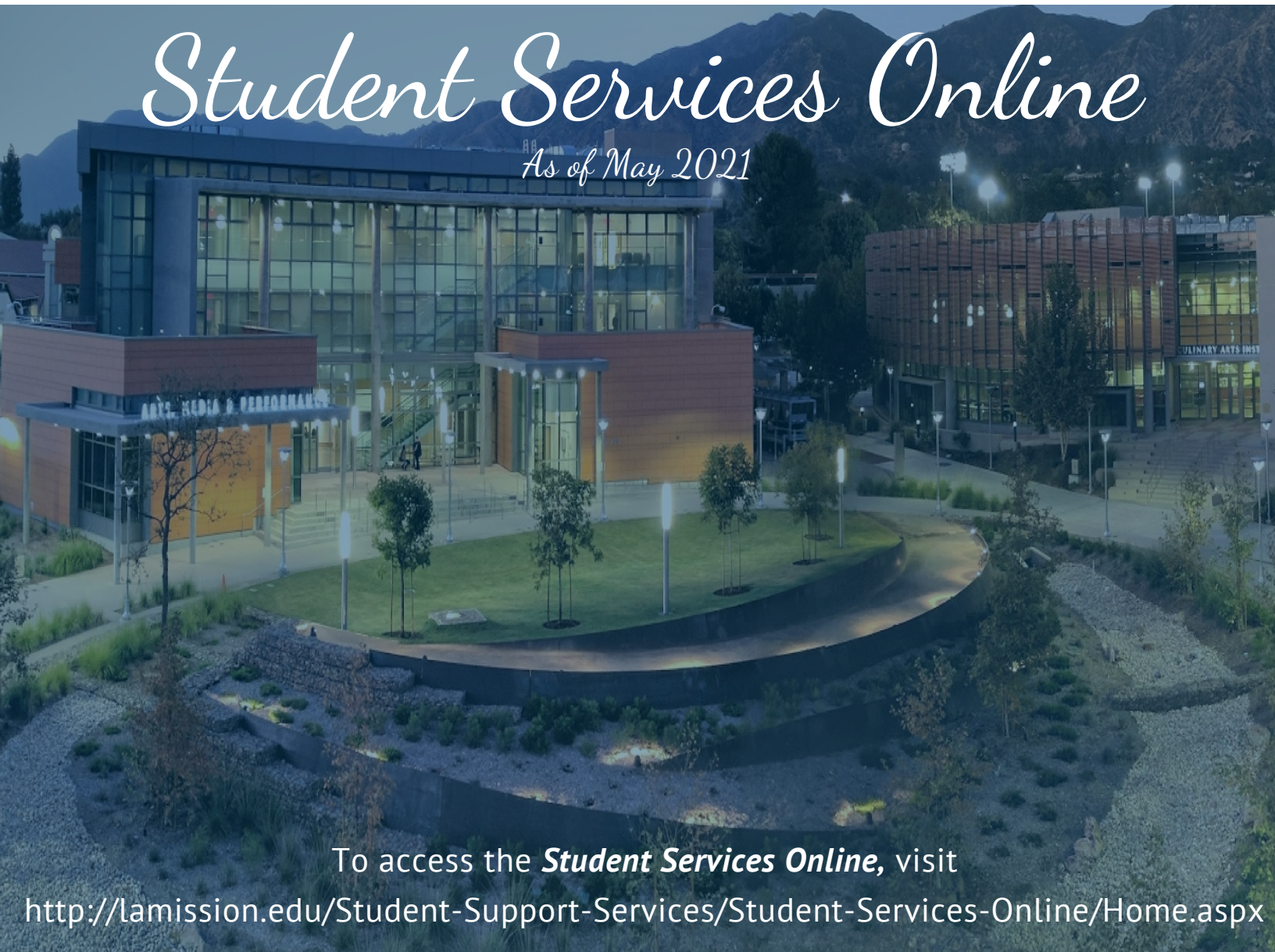

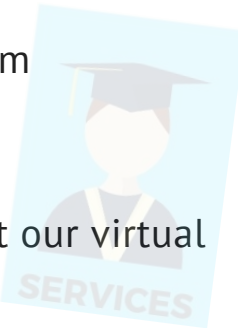

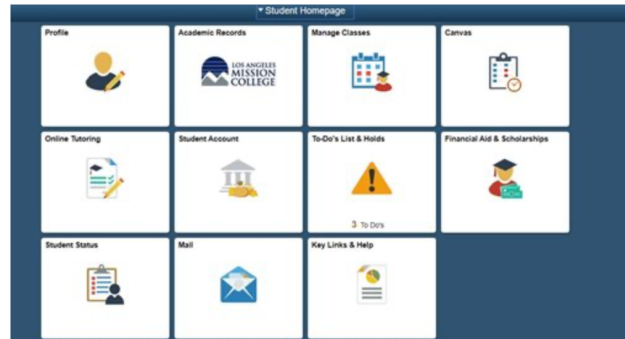

Step 1: Click on the "To-Do List and Holds" icon.



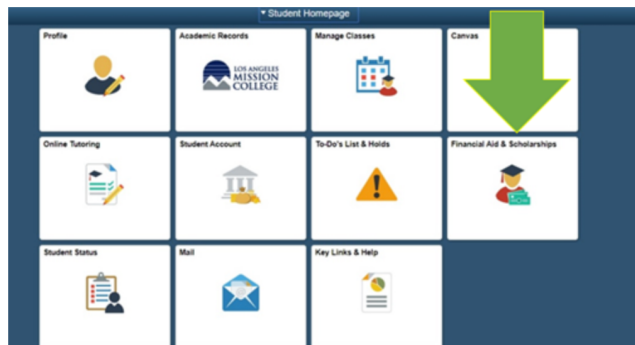
Step 2: After being redirected to your To-Do List & Holds your pending items status should be marked as **Initiated** along with a due date of when they have to be submitted.

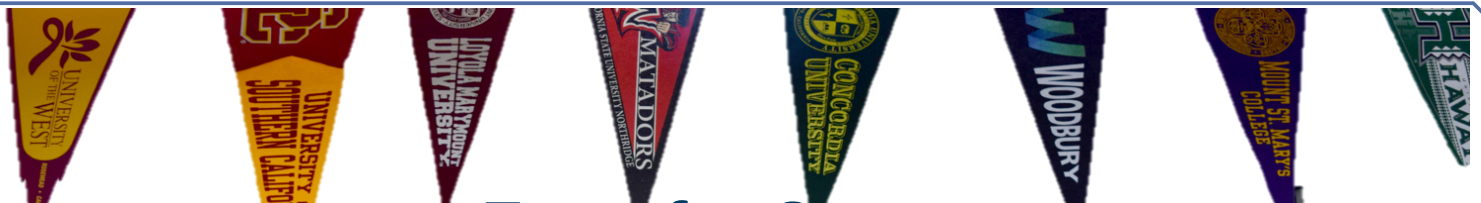

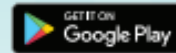
